

NOTICE OF DISCONTINUANCE

Section 213 of the *Code of Civil Procedure*, CQLR, c. C-25.01

GENERAL INFORMATION

This form allows the **plaintiff(s)** to put an end to the proceedings brought against the defendants before the Human Rights Tribunal.

PROCEDURE

NOTIFICATION

You must notify your *Notice of Discontinuance* to all the parties to the proceeding.

For example, notification may be made by registered mail, courier service (Purolator, Dicom, etc.) or by court bailiff.

FILING WITH THE COURT OFFICE

You must **file 2 copies** (the original and a copy) of your *Notice of Discontinuance* along with the proof of its notification to the other parties with the office of the Court of Québec in the district where the *Application to Institute Proceedings* was filed. The district is indicated on that Application.

JUDICIAL FEES

You do not have to pay judicial fees to file your *Notice of Discontinuance*.
